Covid-19 Policies

In this document we will outline all of the guidelines we are implementing for the Stonewall Sports Columbus Spring 21 Kickball season.

FACE COVERINGS

In accordance with state regulations, face coverings are mandatory for everyone at all of Columbus' indoor and outdoor facilities. The state mandate requires face coverings be worn indoors and outdoors at all times, even when social distancing can be achieved. Face coverings are not required when actively playing.

PLAYERS, CAPTAINS, SPECTATORS AND BOARD MEMBERS

- Everyone MUST adhere to six-foot physical distancing while at the facility/field.
- Everyone MUST conduct daily symptom assessments, anyone experiencing symptoms MUST stay home.
- Face coverings must be worn at all times unless actively participating.
- Spectators are not allowed on the field of play or near the bench areas.
- No one should congregate in common areas or parking lots before or after events, games or practices.

BOARD MEMBERS, UMPIRES, BASE REFS

- All Board Members, Umpires, and Base Refs are required to self-monitor and are prohibited from working if they show any symptoms of the coronavirus.
- All Board Members, Umpires, and Base Refs are required to have a face covering on their person at all times, and to wear the covering when on a field.

RULES OF THE GAME

- No touching rules implemented wherever possible: high fives, handshakes, etc.
- Only the umpire should handle lineup cards/score sheets for games.
- No spitting or eating seeds, gum, or other similar products by anyone in attendance.
- Captains are responsible for enforcement of all Covid-19 policies with their team members.
- Players MUST not share water or equipment. If equipment must be shared, proper sanitation should be administered between users.
- Compliant game balls must be designated to each team for use while that team is playing defense. Clean and wipe down foul balls and home run balls that are retrieved by spectators.
